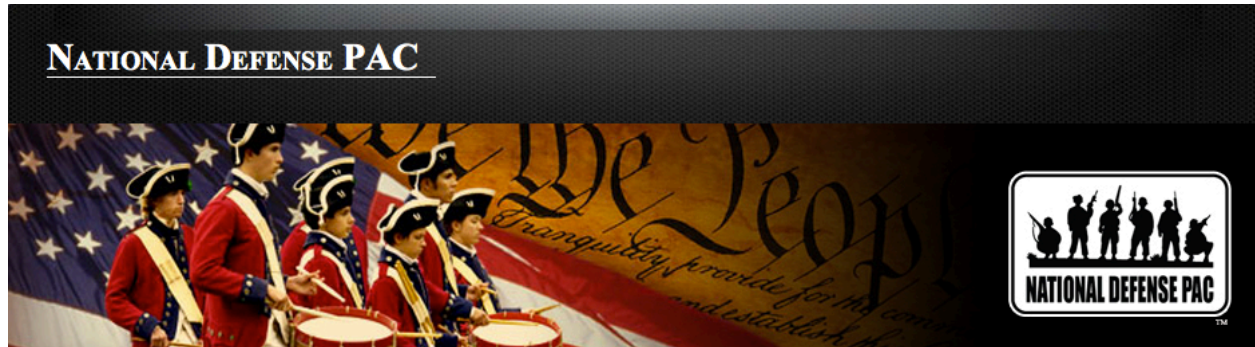

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- **NATIONAL DEFENSE PAC** today announces with pride its endorsement of **Dr. Paul Chabot to represent California's 31st District** in the United States Congress. Dr. Chabot is an Iraq War veteran, first serving in the Office of Naval Intelligence and later with the Defense Intelligence Agency. Chabot currently serves with the U.S. Pacific Fleet at the rank of Lieutenant Commander with the Navy Reserve.
