Support Group, who provided air combat power projection throughout the CENTCOM Area of Responsibility, and also served as a hub for strategic airlift operations and as an intermediate staging base for transiting personnel and equipment in support of operations in Afghanistan. Colonel Ostrov also had the unique opportunity to serve the US State Department in support of the US Special Envoy to Sudan and also served as the Legislative and Interagency Liaison for USTRANSCOM in Washington DC. Before retiring, she served as the Chief of the Global Combat Support Division at Headquarters, Pacific Air Forces. Colonel Ostrov is a highly accomplished and decorated Air Force officer, and has been honored with the Air Force Meritorious Medal (7 OLC), the Defense Superior Service Medal, the Bronze Star, and the Legion of Merit.

Since retirement from active duty, Shirlene immediately assumed her leadership role as President and CEO of Ares Mobility Solutions, Inc. Shirlene is also a co-founder of a non-profit 501(c)3 Hawaiian Cultural School in the National Capitol Region, where she serves as the Chairman of the Board. She also serves on the Board of Directors of the Women's Mentoring Network, a nationwide organization dedicated to women reaching their full potential. Shirlene and her husband Mark, also a retired Air Force officer, have been happily married for 26 years and have 15-year-old twins, Jessica and Julia. Shirlene and her family make their home in Mililani, Hawaii.
