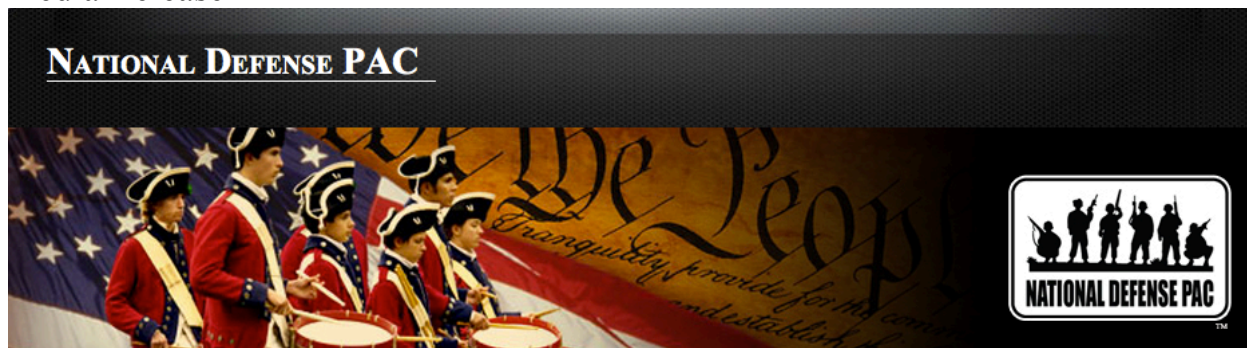

His awards include the Master Army Aviator Badge, Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal, the Joint Services Commendation Medal, the Army Commendation Medal with bronze oak leaf cluster, the Army Achievement Medal and 2 bronze oak leaf cluster, the Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal with silver oak leaf cluster, National Defense Service medal with bronze service star, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Armed Forces Reserve medal with silver hour glass and M device, Army Service Ribbon, Army Reserve Components Overseas Training Ribbon with 4 device, NATO Medal, PA 20 Year Medal, MG T.R. White Medal & the Gen. T.J. Stewart Medal. He is also the recipient of the honorable orders of Saint Michael and Saint George.
